We are pleased to share that Children's Home Society of California (CHS) is now enrolling eligible families for subsidized child care through our Child Care Payment Program (CCPP). Please review the chart below to determine if your family is currently income eligible based on your family size (you, your children under the age of 18, and a secondary parent if they live in the home) and total gross monthly household income (before taxes and deductions):

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Please bring the following documentation for yourself (and a secondary parent residing in the household, if applicable) in order for CHS staff to determine your eligibility for child care services.

- One full month of income from August or September 2024 (including check stubs, child support, etc.) (per parent)
- If one or both parents attend school/training, bring an electronic print-out of the class schedule for all classes
- Child(ren)'s birth records (e.g. birth certificates or other reliable documentation indicating the relationship of the child to the parent)
- School-aged child(ren)'s school bell schedule(s)
- Immunization records for all children under the age of 5
- Child care provider information (name, address, and phone number) You may select a license-exempt (friend, family, neighbor), licensed family child care home, or licensed center to care for your child

We suggest that you meet with the prospective child care provider to take a tour of the facility, review rates and hours of operation, and ask if space is available for your child(ren). If you do not have a child care provider, please visit www.chs-ca.org where you can search for licensed child care providers that meet the needs of your family.
